



Orff Instrument Recording Guidelines

1. Decide with your student if you prefer to make 3 short video submissions in FlipGrid or 1 longer one using the pause button in between. (Note: if more than one instrument is assigned to a movement give one to each Orff student. If you only have one Orff student they can play their choice)

Display name: student last name, first name

Link: blank

Title: Teacher First and Last Name, School Name
